

ENGLISH

Following the National Curriculum we will be learning our reading, writing and speaking and listening objectives through our work on the topic of 'Potions'. We will be looking at how characters can change and writing about a baddie becoming a goodie after drinking a potion. We will also be looking at the features of a playscript and writing our own by adapting a story, which we will hopefully then put on for the school and parents.

At the end of our topic we will be writing letters to an alien to explain all about our learning this term.

MATHS

Following the curriculum, in this term we will be focusing on place value and the expanded written method for subtraction. Mental multiplication and division using our knowledge of times tables. We will be looking at position, direction and angles and also fractions of number using our 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 8x and 10x tables. We will also be starting to look at measuring capacity in litres and millilitres and convert between whole or half litres and millilitres.

We will continue to use problem solving and reasoning tasks to embed our learning.

We will be welcoming a visitor to school to talk about the history of anaesthetics and answer any questions we have.

SCIENCE

In this term we will be exploring Solids, Liquids and Gases through our Potions Topic. We will be looking at what makes a solid, liquid and gas. We will be conducting experiments to learn about their different states and how they are made up of different particles. We will be looking at the dangers of some solids liquids and gases and their labelling.

FRENCH
