# Medium Term Planning Web 2019/2020

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Self-confidence and Self-awareness

The first two weeks will focus on children becoming more confident to leave parents at drop off time and building relationships with the Cygnets staff.

#### Making Relationships

There will be lots of activities out for the children to develop their friendships with others such as the Home Corner role play area and the large construction area outside.

### Managing feelings and Behaviour

We will create our own set of classroom rules as well as learning the boundaries and expectations of Cygnets. We will begin to use our 'Rainbow' behaviour chart where children can work themselves up to the rainbow to earn a sticker.

### Physical Development

Moving and Handling

In our PE sessions we will focus on safety rules for the hall and then focus on moving safely in the space using our eyes to check where we are going and to make sure we don't bump into people. We will look at different ways of moving and simple balances.

#### Health and Self Care

We will focus on going to the toilet independently, getting ourselves undressed and dressed for PE and Forest School and washing our hands for lunchtimes and after the toilet.

## Communication and Language

<u>Listening & Attention</u>

Our first few weeks will focus on listening skills for carpet time and lots of listening for sounds and oral segmenting and blending in our phonics sessions. We will practise sitting on the carpet and listening to stories and also listening during teaching times.

## Speaking

We will do lots of talking in our first couple of weeks about our Summer Holiday boxes! We will sing songs and rhymes daily too.

## Literacy

Writing

For the first few weeks we will be focusing a lot on gross and fine motor skills that help to develop the muscles needed for writing. We will 'write' about our summer holiday and every day we will write our name as we come into school.

## Reading

Every day we will share books with our friends and adults. Every day we will have a story at the end of the day and sometimes before lunch too.



# Expressive Arts and Design

Exploring using media and materials

We will sing songs and use the instruments to explore sounds. We will have the opportunity to explore paints and how they change when they are mixed. We will also have chance to explore the 'Creation Station' and the goodies hidden in the drawers!

Being Imaginative

We will have our Home Corner set up to role play.

## **Mathematics**

Number

We will do a lot of counting forwards and backwards to 10 and really focus on number recognition to 5, 10 or 20. We will practise counting objects 1:1, touching or moving the objects as we count. We will focus on matching the correct amount to the written number and see if we can recognise our age!

Shape, Space and Measure

We will look at 2D shapes to see which ones we know and use them to make pictures and patterns. We will compare our heights and hand sizes to see how we are different!

## Understanding the World

People and Communities

We will share what we did with our families over the summer holidays and share our boxes with each other.

The World

We will talk about the differences between each other and explore the school environment.

**Technology** 

We will use the interactive board for phonics games and drawing.
